

## Requesting a Rotation/Preceptorship with Tepeyac OB/GYN

Through this program, students have the opportunity to travel to Tepeyac's Fairfax, VA medical office and gain insight and experience on practicing merciful medicine.

### STAGE ONE

- Resume or Curriculum Vitae – Make sure to provide your educational background at both the undergraduate and medical school levels, previous experiences in the medical field, and any volunteer activity related to a medical and/or catholic nature.
- One page document explaining why you are interested in a rotation with Tepeyac. Your submission should include a specific area of interest in the OB/GYN field.
- Details of a schedule of your availability looking 6 months to 1 year in advance. Include number of weeks desired, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> choices for a date range, and days per week and hours per day you are requesting.
- Amount of stipend provided from university for the rotation.

*Once stage 1 of the application process is complete and approved, you can move on to stage two.*

### STAGE TWO

- PPD / Vaccine Administration Record
- Official Transcripts from both your undergraduate institution and medical school – these must be sealed and mailed directly to:
